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This five-year Programme, started in March 1975 and funded by British Shipowners, has involved research and development work within UK shipping companies, experiments on board ships, and studies of several of the shipping industry's central manpower policies and systems.

Controlled on a joint basis by Owners, Unions and the Department of Trade, the Programme represents an attempt to diagnose the industry's difficulties in retaining seafaring manpower, and to formulate paths towards solutions.

The Programme is now in its final year and this compilation outlines the main papers and reports produced to date. A few further reports will be issued later this year; details of these will be covered by a supplement to this list.
